

Nebraska Dairy Princess Rules

To be chosen as a dairy princess...

As a Dairy Princess...

- 1. Either you, your parents or guardians must be actively engaged in the production of milk for sale to a licensed plant at some time during the current year prior to the local contest.
 - You will qualify if a brother or sister has taken over the family farm.
 - > The farm must contribute to the Nebraska Dairy Promotion Checkoff.
- 2. _____ Your parents or guardians are employed on a dairy farm.
 - Employment for the parent or guardian consists of regular full-time work (at least 30 hours/week) on a dairy farm in a dairy-related capacity for at least one year prior to the local contest.
 - > The farm must contribute to the Nebraska Dairy Promotion Checkoff.
- 3. _____ You are employed:
 - part-time or full-time on a dairy farm in a dairy related capacity;
 - > the farm must contribute to the Nebraska Dairy Promotion Checkoff; and
 - if requested, you can provide verification of employment
- 4. You have an interest or are affiliated with the dairy industry.
 - > Could include, but not limited to, showing dairy cattle in 4-H or FFA.

General Candidate Eligibility

- 1. Must be a Nebraska resident.
- 2. ____ Must be a US citizen or a legal resident under the US VISA program..
- 3. ____ Must be single, never been married.
- 4. ____ Must not be pregnant or have had any children at any time prior to the contest or during your reign.
- Must be at least a high school junior and not yet 24 years old on July 1 of the year of the contest.
- Must not have been convicted of a felony offense involving crimes of moral turpitude (conduct that is contrary to community standards of justice, honesty or good morals); be on probation; or any offenses involving the use or possession of alcohol, illegal drugs or tobacco.
- 7. ____ Must be a genuine user of dairy products and a passionate supporter of the dairy industry.
- 8. _____ Must not participate or be associated with the sale of raw milk directly to consumers.

You must be available for personal appearances as scheduled in advance during your reign as State Dairy Princess.

As a candidate for Dairy Princess, you must be neat and well groomed whenever and wherever you appear as such, and your conduct must be exemplary at all times in accordance with the proper image of a Dairy Princess.

If you are selected as a Dairy Princess, you must be willing to enter into an agreement agreeing to serve as such. If you become the Nebraska State Dairy Princess, you must be willing to reign for an entire year beginning on the day of the Nebraska Dairy Princess Coronation.

CODE OF CONDUCT

Although it is not the purpose or intent of the program to restrict or infringe upon personal freedoms of the dairy princesses, the following Code of Conduct is established to uphold the integrity and success of the Nebraska Dairy Princess Program. Your conduct must be exemplary at all times in accordance with the proper image of a dairy princess. In addition to maintaining the eligibility requirements described above, each eligible candidate must adhere to the following Code of Conduct if selected as a dairy princess:

Project and deliver dairy messages with enthusiasm and positive attitude.
Be considerate and respectful of other princesses and other dairy industry leaders.
Be on time to all scheduled appearance and activities requested.
Will not receive a conviction of any felony offense involving crimes of moral turpitude; be on probation;
or any offenses involving the use or possession of alcohol, illegal drugs, or tobacco.
Will not consume alcohol or tobacco during a princess event.
Social media activity must include respectable speech and appropriate photos at all times as you are
representing the dairy industry to others.
All body piercings (excluding earrings) and tattoos must be covered during appearances as a dairy
princess.
Clothing should be appropriate and professional for public appearances.

Scheduling

The dairy princess consultant will coordinate and schedule all Dairy Princess appearances. Media interviews including, newspaper, radio and television must be scheduled and approved by the princess consultant prior to any interview.

Payment

Payment and reimbursement for travel, food and lodging will be made at the discretion of Midwest Dairy for an approved and scheduled appearance of the Dairy Princess.

During the State Contest, Midwest Dairy will cover food and lodging costs for all candidates.
