Handbook Updates: New in 2022

- **No county limits.** Counties are encouraged to send all eligible representatives to attend the May Dairy Promotion and Leadership event. (See page 20 of the handbook.)
- Clarity on State Titles. A candidate selected as Princess Kay of the Milky Way must not hold any other state title or leadership position and must be willing to step down from state titles immediately after being named Princess Kay. Additionally, state titles are to be disclosed. (Page 21)
- Clarity on Eligibility. Must show MN Driver's license or neighboring state's (Midwest Dairy state that does not have an active princess program) driver's license and MN high school transcript. (Page 22)
